

WHAT JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES DON'T DARE TELL YOU AT THE DOOR!

Jehovah's Witnesses teach that all churches other than their own are from Satan.

Jehovah's Witnesses teach that god is going to destroy you and your family and everyone that does not become a Jehovah's Witness at Armageddon.

Jehovah's Witnesses teach that the penalty for smoking is eternal damnation.

Jehovah's Witnesses have written their own translation of the Bible, and have changed and added words to agree with their teachings.

If you become a Jehovah's Witness, you are required to attend 260 meetings a year at the Kingdom Hall. Jehovah's Witnesses are required to die rather than accept a blood transfusion. Anyone accepting a transfusion will be destroyed by Jehovah.

Jehovah's Witnesses built a house in 1925 near San Diego, California and deeded it to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. They taught that these patriarchs would be resurrected in that year.

Jehovah's Witnesses teach that Jesus already came the second time in 1914. They said the date was 1874, and taught that for 40 years.
