

WHAT MORMONS DON'T DARE TELL YOU AT THE DOOR!

Did you know that Mormons teach that all churches other than their own are from Satan?

Did you know that Joseph Smith was a false prophet and predicted the end of the world for 1891? That a Mormon temple would be built in Independence, Missouri, before the generation of 1832 passed away? That the LDS church doesn't even own this Temple Lot, and it stands vacant to this day?

Did you know that over fifty other false prophecies of Joseph Smith have been fully documented? (God demands 100% accuracy from His prophets. See Deuteronomy chapters 13 and 18.)

Did you know that Mormons teach that if you drink alcohol, coffee, or tea, or use tobacco products you can never be "worthy" to meet god? This teaching is known as the "Word of Wisdom."

Did you know that if you become a Mormon, you are required to attend a minimum of 156 meetings per year at the Ward Chapel?

Did you know that if you become a Mormon, you will be required to give ten percent of your income to the Mormon Church (tithing), plus contribute to building funds and "fast offerings"?

Did you know that if you become a Mormon, you or your children will be encouraged to be baptized, confirmed, married, and go through hours-long "sealing" and "endowment" ceremonies in the Mormon temple for all of your dead relatives? That is why Mormons are so interested in genealogy.

Did you know that Mormons teach that Jesus and Lucifer are spirit brothers? That god is just an exalted man? That there are many gods and goddesses, and that God is married to many wives? That you are the sexually begotten offspring of god and one of his wives?

Mormons teach that Jesus was sexually begotten by the father with Mary, who was his daughter, and was no longer a virgin after the father "overshadowed" her.

Did you know that Mormons teach that you can't go to heaven (the "Celestial Kingdom") unless you are a "worthy" Temple Mormon? You can become a god, too, if you are a "worthy" Mormon. You must be married, and married in a Mormon Temple to be a god. (The Bible says, "Before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me" – Isaiah 43:10).

Did you know that non-Mormon and "unworthy" Mormon friends and relatives will not be able to attend your celestial marriage ceremony in the temple?

Did you know that Mormons teach that the United States Constitution "will hang by a thread" and the Mormon Church will establish a theocracy (religious government) in America?

Mormons coming to your door will ask you to read the *Book of Mormon*, and then pray to know whether it is true. Ask them why there is not one historical or archaeological fact to support the *Book of Mormon*, in spite of the lofty claims of Mormon laymen. If the *Book of Mormon* is scripture, why have there been thousands of material changes since the original 1830 version? Why pray about the *Book of Mormon*?

The truth is:

You do not need an organized religion to go to heaven. Eternal life in heaven is a free gift from God based on Jesus' sacrifice on the cross (I John 5:11-12, Colossians 1:19-20, 2:13-15).
